Improving an Effective Safety and Health Inspection Program

This workshop will highlight various aspects of an improved inspection program, using the PDCA (Plan, do, check Act) model. Plans for improvement generated such as items revised training program for those conducting the inspections, providing mentors for those who are new to conducting inspections, revision of the inspection documentation and a detailed plan to ensure that all areas of the 550 acre site is inspected.

JOINT MEETING WITH THE METROPOLITAN CHAPTER OF THE ASSE

Thursday, January 21, 2010, the Metropolitan Chapters of the AIHA and ASSE held a joint meeting at the New York Blood Center. The response to the meeting was overwhelming and members and guests of each chapter had the opportunity to network and "break bread" together. After both chapter Presidents welcomed everyone and made announcements Sandy Camacho, NYC FD Deputy Chief Inspector/Laboratory Inspection Unit supervisor made a presentation. The topic was Hazardous Materials Permits Requirements for Both Laboratory and Non-Laboratory Settings based on the 2008 Revised FDNY Fire Code. He highlighted the responsibilities of the Lab Unit based on these revisions. The Lab Unit is in charge of inspecting every college, high school, hospital, testing and industrial laboratory in the city on an annual basis (about 6000 labs); every hospital medical gas system; and every facility that stores hazardous materials (other than flammable or combustible liquids) such as corrosives, flammable solids, water reactives, oxidizers, pyrophorics, toxics and cryogenic gases.
