For your safety and to make the collection of materials less costly and more efficient, we ask that:

- If a product is still usable, try to give it to someone who can use it. Useable items left at the ECC (such as aerosol paint cans, unopened motor oil, etc..)can be picked up FREE by visitors.
- Please bring liquid paint sorted by type (i.e. latex, oil based, lead based)
- Please keep chemicals in their original containers; place broken or leaking containers inside a second container of like material
- If a container has no label and its contents are know, please place a label on the container clearly stating the contents.
- DO NOT transport chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle... put them in the trunk
