### **Responsibilities**

Responsible for providing technical advice and support with respect to matters impacting occupational health and industrial hygiene issues for CSX Transportation. This position provides for the coordination of all industrial hygiene issues related to Hearing Conservation, Respiratory Protection, Control of Hazardous Energy, Indoor Air Quality and Mold to assure and demonstrate full compliance with all government and company standards. This position is primarily responsible for managing the 3rd party contractor used to perform medical surveillance required by OSHA and FRA for Hearing Conservation and Respiratory Protection. Reports to Director of Industrial Hygiene.

1. Manages the 3rd party vendor used to perform medical surveillance for employees that are required to participate in annual audiometric testing and/or respiratory protection clearance.
2. Provides advice on occupational health and industrial hygiene concerns and works with employees at all organizational levels to affect corrective action strategies. Serves as adviser to the new chemical approval committee for items related to worker health.
3. Delivers industrial hygiene training on required regulatory, corporate and site-specific topics.
4. Develops, recommends and implements practical, functional approaches to resolve industrial hygiene issues in support of CSX strategies for achieving regulatory/policy compliance.
5. Establishes industrial hygiene monitoring plan, conducts monitoring activities, and provides technical guidance in the implementation of controls to minimize exposure to contaminants.
6. Provides expertise during concept and design phases of manufacturing processes to ensure that sound safety and health control methodologies are integrated into the design.
7. Develops industrial hygiene policies/procedures and ensures that requirements are effectively integrated into standard operating procedures.
8. Conducts internal industrial hygiene audits to verify compliance levels. Evaluates site health and safety systems, procedures and processes and implements changes to maximize effectiveness.
9. Reviews current and proposed regulations/corporate requirements and recommends appropriate program measures to ensure compliance.

## **Qualifications**

\*Masters degree in Industrial Hygiene or Environmental Health Science and five to seven years experience in Industrial hygiene and safety required. Seven to 10 years experience preferred.

\*Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH) and Certified Safety Professional (CSP) certification preferred. Must be eligible to test for CIH within 6 months of hire.

\*Industrial Hygiene and regulatory knowledge required. Must possess good computer skills including MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint. Proven and effective written and verbal communication skills required. Must have hazardous materials management, safety and purchasing knowledge and skills. Must wear all required protective equipment.

\*Must be able to work varying hours/days and on call in 24/7 environment, with extended periods of time away from home.

\*Must be able to travel at least 50%

\*Must be able to work in all weather conditions, confined spaces, heights, office environments and with hazardous materials.
