The Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS) has been adopted by the United Nations. Countries around the world are now considering implementation of this approach to classify health, physical, and environmental hazards of chemicals; convey information on labels; and prepare safety data sheets. The provisions of the GHS will be described, as well as the implications for U.S. hazard communication practices. Practical effects on companies will be addressed. The status of implementation in the United States and in other countries will also be discussed
