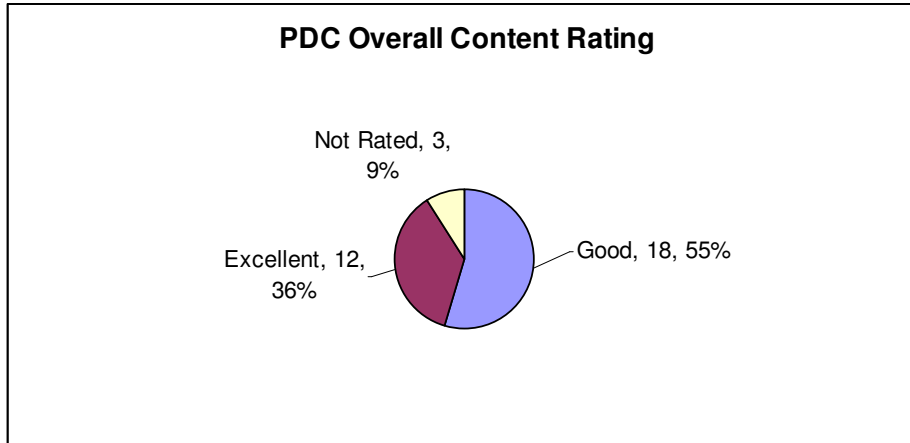


AIHA INDIANA SECTION FALL 2008 PDC SPEAKER EVALUATION SUMMARY
