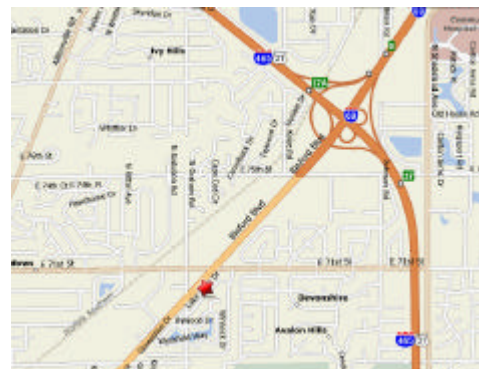

He has nearly 30 years experience in federal and state government affairs, and has developed government affairs programs for three national associations.
