"INTERGRATING MULTIPLE JOB ANALYSIS METHODS INTO A SINGLE RISK ASSESSMENT TOOL"

Typically ergonomists use a different job analysis method depending upon the type of task. For example, a lifting task would often be evaluated using the NIOSH Guidelines, whereas a repetitive hand task might be evaluated using the ACGIH-TLV for Hand Activity or the Upper Extremity Strain Index. But, employers need a "simple" tool that evaluates the relative risk of one job task or process against others in order to help set priorities. So as consultants and EHS staff, what do we do? This presentation will address this issue and introduce an "integrated" tool for discussion.
