The Industrial Hygiene Consultant is responsible for:

Consultation

- Provides first tier support and direction for field staff and external clients on all matters relating to sampling methods, strategy or in-field issues relating to equipment use.
- Coordinates with others (chemists, IH Technical Manager, Masters, etc.) when complexity of issues requires.
- Maintains records of all consultation efforts and follows up as necessary to assure problem resolution.
- Logistics of all owned and leased industrial hygiene instrumentation (including maintenance, repair, and calibration).

Field Industrial Hygiene Work

- Conducts complex and challenging industrial hygiene field surveys for large complex accounts along with field co-travels with other Loss Control staff in support of the IH product offering.

Training

- Assists technical manager through the identification, development and presentation of training when appropriate through the use of online web materials and courses, updates to both intranet and external site and face to face workshops where necessary.

Equipment repair, calibration, and maintenance

- Identifies in a proactive manner the use of new technology to better serve client needs.
- Assures that the entire fleet of equipment performs in the field as expected in a reliable manner through calibration and scheduled maintenance.
- Budget performance monitoring of equipment related expenses including, but not limited to: shipping, external repair and parts, external calibration services, supplies, expendables (batteries, etc.), and external rental equipment
