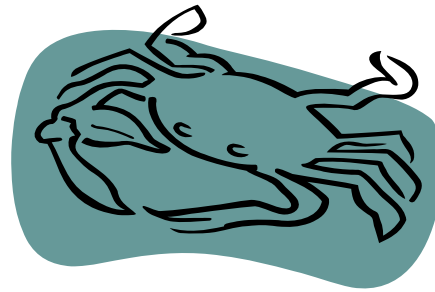

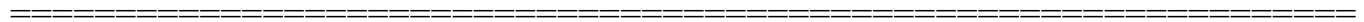

# Comprehensive Industrial Hygiene Examination Review Course

May 31 - September 27, 2006

Wednesday Evenings  
7:00 - 9:30 PM

The purpose of this course is to provide a comprehensive review of the field of industrial hygiene and to aid in the preparation for the American Board of Industrial Hygiene ([ABIH](#)) comprehensive examination. This course will be taught by qualified faculty with extensive experience in industrial hygiene and related areas.

Topics covered include: calculations; conversions; statistics; sampling and analytic procedures for gases, vapors, and particulates; ventilation; indoor and outdoor air pollution; respiratory protection; toxicology; ergonomics; physical agents; regulations; standards and guidelines; biohazards; and study techniques. This course is not intended for entry level industrial hygienists. Attendees must have a basic understanding of mathematics, statistics, and chemistry. ABIH CM points pending approval.
