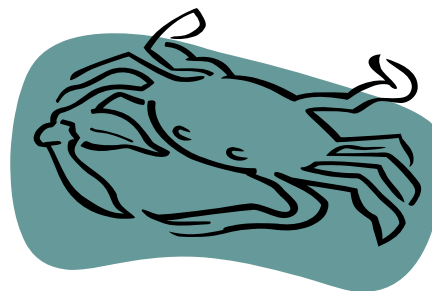

Meeting called to order at 1740 hrs

President (Mark Isenstein) – Agenda for meeting was to discuss next PDC, upcoming meetings, collection of membership dues and booth activity at next Maryland Environmental, Health & Safety Conference. An e-mail from national AIHA was distributed to those in attendance to decide if chapter wanted to participate in memberclicks service or have national headquarters collect local section dues. Everyone agreed to get clarification from national on cost for collecting dues. If no cost was associated with the activity then enlisting national assistance should be pursued. Mark to discuss with national. Selected dates for the last three meetings in 2007. The dates are September 7th, October 4th and November 1st. The months for the first three meetings of 2008 were also selected. Those are March, April and May. April was tentatively chosen as the month for the former presidents dinner.
