The Subject Matter Expert (SME) team for the Asbestos Analysts Registry (AAR) serves to provide technical expertise and guidance to the continued scientific integrity of the AAR program. SME team members:

- ✦ Review Organization Applications to the AAR program;
- ✦ Participate in SME team conference calls to evaluate the review and registration process to maintain consistency between reviewers;
- ✦ Provide technical guidance in the revision of the AAR Policy and AAR Application;
- ✦ Are available as on-call experts for technical questions;
- ✦ And serve, as needed, on an ad hoc Technical Review Board to provide recommendations to management regarding technical aspects of registry programs parameters.

To qualify to volunteer as an SME for the AAR program, candidates should minimally meet the following requirements:

- ✦ The SME candidate shall be a graduate of an accredited institution of higher education holding an associate's or bachelor's degree in industrial hygiene, chemistry, physics, engineering, biology or other scientific discipline.
- ✦ The SME candidate has engaged a majority of his/her time in analytical laboratory activities (analysis or interpretation of data) for at least five years (with an associate's degree) or three years (with a bachelor's degree).

In all, participation as an SME for the AAR program carries with it responsibility and effort (generally a few hours a month). In return for your efforts, you will have the opportunity to participate in an important process, contribute back to your profession, and to work with some outstanding industry leaders.

SME team members are strongly encouraged to be members in good standing with the AIHA[®], although this is not required.
